Volunteer Checklist: _____ *Street Assignment

A note from the Conservation Commission:

If for scheduling reasons, it will be more convenient for you to go out on a day other than Saturday, the 7th, you are welcome to pick a time of your own choosing.

Blue, "Green Up Day" litter bags will be available beginning Friday, April 29. They will be found at the usual locations: the Lyme Country Store, the Town Offices vestibule, the Ace Hardware/Post Office vestibule and the Lyme Center Post Office.

*If you want to recycle what you collect, the recyclables must be kept separate from other litter and debris. **The blue bags cannot go into the recyclable compactor.** Their contents must be dumped. You might find it easier to use an open top container like a bucket or box. Matt and Tim will be happy to help you with that process. If you find tires or other large pieces of debris, please report them to Dina Cutting (dina@lymenh.gov) to arrange pick up. Also, **do not leave collection bags on the roadside.** There is no formal pickup scheduled for them.*

Blue litter bags that contain some mix of roadside trash, non-recyclable items and/or recyclable pieces, should you choose not to separate them out, have to go in the household trash compactor. This can be done at no charge on Sunday, May 8 and Wednesday, May 11. Blue bags must be used. No personal household trash allowed.
